As of March 1995, the history or whereabouts of the other children of Matias & Felipa Telesforo, Guadalupe, Sostenas, Pablo, Maria (Delfina?), and Dolores are unknown. However, information obtained during an interview (Feb. 1995) with Francisco Quintanilla, Jr. (1905-), Guadalupe married a Domingo Garcia, moved to Tampico, Mexico and had children named; Felipe, Oscar, and Nena. Sostenas married a Ramon Silva, had no children, and lived in Laureles Division of the King Ranch(?) (probably buired there or in Corpus Christi, Tx). And Dolores married a ? Blanco (parents of a Nicho Blanco....cook at the King Ranch) and they are probably buried in Riviera or Kingsville, Tx. I cannot find death certificates on any of these "other children" of Matias at the Texas State Archives or Texas Dept. of Health (death certificiates records in Texas started in 1903). All of Matias' children were probably born in or around the Matamoros or Camargo, Mexico areas. Matias was born Feb. 1840 in Matamoros, Mexico(?) area. His parents are probably buried in Matamoros, Mexico.

When Matias first came to the U.S. he worked around the Ft. Brown Area (Brownsville, Texas) and on the Yturria & Cortina Ranches (Lower Rio Grande Valley area. It is said that Capt. Richard King gave Matias a job at the King Ranch in 1884 (King died a year later in 1885). We don't know if Matias' wife, Felipa, moved to the King Ranch with him. The last child born to both of them "in Mexico" was a "Ma Delfina" (Maria?) in 1885 according to the 1900 U.S. Census. Maybe when Matias went to work on the King Ranch he left his wife Felipa in Matamoros, Mexico to have their last child(?). Or maybe Felipa joined them later, maybe not(??). Maybe Felipa died giving birth to Maria (?), etc. Felipa is not listed in the 1900 Census with Matias and he is listed as a widower living with some of his children in Nueces County Pct #4. (See attached 1900 Census info.) Note: Nueces Co.Pct #4 later became Kleberg Co. in 1913.

Maria, one of the Matias' daughters, was the companion-maid of Mrs. Clara Driscoll of Corpus Christi, Tx. Story has it that Maria, while in New York with Mrs. Driscoll, met a man, married him, and never returned to Texas. In the recent interview (Feb.1995) with Francisco Quintanilla, Jr. he stated that sometime in 1936, while taking 15 King Ranch horses to the Belmont Track in New York, attempted to visit his aunt Maria. Francisco went to her home (approx. 30 minutes from the Belmont Track) but could not find her at home. Pressed for time, Francisco returned to Texas. However he was informed by Maria's neighbors(there in New York) that Maria was still living there but that her husband was deceased. Then sometime during the 1940's, "some Anglo persons" from New York state came to Kingsville, Tx. looking for "Alvarez" relatives. They said they were related to Maria. Rita Alvarez Quintanilla (Francisco, Jr.'s mother and Maria's sister), had Maria's address and they would write to each other frequently. At present we don't have any copies of these letters or know what Maria's married name was or her New York address.

Another of Matias son's, Manuel, (originally thought to be the youngest child...but not really), was born in Mexico Dec. 1882; he never married and is probably buried in Riviera or Kingsville, Tx.

One of Matias' sons, Luis, continued living in Mexico (Matamoros?) and probably didn't move to the King Ranch (we think) until sometime between 1894-1898. His daughter, Guadalupe, was born in Mexico in 1894 and his son Pablo was born in Texas (King Ranch-Santa Cruz) in 1898 or 1900. None of the Alvarez' show up in the 1880 Census, the 1890 is non-existent (destroyed by fire) and Matias does not show up in the 1910 or 1920 Census; only shows up in the 1990 Census as the head of the household. He must have died between 1900 & 1910 (?). However Francisco Quintanilla, Jr., grandson of Matias, stated in the Feb. 1995 interview that his grandfather Matias was living with them until his death around 1919(?). As a small boy he remembered his grandfather well. Francisco, Jr. states that they all lived in a little community called "Radiche" which was located on the east side of Hwy. 77 between Ricardo & Riviera, Tx. approx. three miles north of Riviera. The Radiche Community was part of the King Ranch and later Mrs. King sold that area to a developer. All of the families, including the homes were moved across the Hwy. to "Santa Cruz". We think this move happened around 1919-1920. Matias was living with his daughter, Rita Alvarez Quintanilla and her husband Francisco Quintanilla Sr. & family there in Radiche. After Matias' death, the Quintanilla family moved across Hwy. 77 (westside) to "Santa Cruz". This area is also located between Ricardo and Riviera, Tx, but on the westside of Hwy 77, approx. three to six miles north of Riviera. According to Francisco, Jr., Matias was buried in the Riviera Cemetery and not in "Radiche" because there was not an "official cemetery" located there, except for a very small one in a field nearby(?). I have checked the 1910 & 1920 Census (Francisco Quintanilla, Sr. household) and did not find Matias listed. (he was probably missed by census takers)

Historical documents at the State Archives say that Matias brought his mother, Francisca, with him to the King Ranch and in 1902-03 this woman was well into her 90's and bed-ridden. Francisca, also know as "the Angel of Goliad", is said to be buried somewhere on the King Ranch in an unmarked grave. Mrs. Richard King knew where she was buried (source: Harbert Davenport & Elena Zamora O'Shea papers at the Texas State Archives).

Regarding Riviera, Tx. Cemetery records, there are some "unknowns" about some of the Alvarez's buried there or Alvarez burial plots, according to the caretaker, Mr. Brown:

1. a Patria Alvarez Born: ? Died: 6/2/34?
(this person is really Petra Alvarez Tijerina; born 1907 and died on 6/3/94. Maybe her grave was bought on 6/2/34). She presently has no gravestone but is buried "somewhere" in Frutoso Ruiz' original 10-12 lot plot (between Frutoso Ruiz and Pablo Alvarez...Pablo is also in the Frutoso tract).

Possibilities: On person # 3; (J. Alvarez).... Maybe this lot was bought by Jerardo(Gerardo) in 1913 before he died in Jan. 1914. However Gerardo is buried in Kingsville, Tx. Or could this be a child of Luis, Eusebio, Jacinto, or Gerardo. They had many children that died as infants, etc. Maybe this lot was never used by an Alvarez family member, but given out to someone else.(?)

On #4; (J.M. Alvarez).....Maybe this lot was bought in 1917 or 1920 by Jacinto M. Alvarez (who is really buired in San Antonio, Tx.), never used it or buried his infants or gave it to someone else and was never documented or changed.(?)

I have checked the Kleberg County Clerk's Office (which did not start registering Alvarez deaths until 1926 and Alvarez births until 1899), the Texas Health Dept. (Vital Statistics Dept.) and the Texas State Archives in Austin, Texas and the above "unknowns" have not been found. It should be noted that just because a death certificate states the "place of death", that does not mean that a person is "buried" in that county where he/she died. After death the body could have been transported for burial elsewhere....ex: to Kleberg County from Bexar County or from Nueces Co. etc.. Or many Kleberg County residents could have died in a Coprus Christi hospital, buried in Kleberg County and the death certificate would still be registered in Nueces County.

Note: Kleberg County was not organized until 1913. It was part of "southwest" Nueces County Pct #4.

In Texas, death certificates were not required until 1903 and not really enforced until the late 1920's or early 1930's. Many women's death certificates were not registered until after 1932. Prior to that many people died and were buried in unmarked graves on farms and ranches, etc. Likewise many were born at home, using "midwives", and the birth's not recorded until later, if at all.....Sometimes women would return to another female relative or parent, say in Mexico, to have their children and later return to

their Texas home. In those cases, birth, marriage, and death information can be found in state or church records in Mexico.

Also checking the Texas State Archives Death Certificate Index (1903-1940), I found no "Matias Alvarez or Felipa Mosqueda Alvarez. In addition, sometimes "informants" in a death certificates could not pronounce or spell the deceased name. For example, in the death certificate of Luis Alvarez, his first name is misspelled (Louis instead of Luis), also in the same certificate Luis' father's name is misspelled and shows "Martias" instead of "Matias". In addition Luis' mother's maiden name is also misspelled.....should be "Mosqueda" instead of "Moscada". However in Luis' brother's (Jerardo or Gerardo) death certificate it has the correct spelling of both their parents. Also the first name of the deceased is shown as "Jerardo" instead of Gerardo and the birth place of his father Matias is shown as San Antonio, Tx, (probably a mistake) whereas in Luis' death certificate, Matias is shown to have been born in Mexico. The "informant" in Gerardo's (Jerardo) death certificate (1914) is his brother Eusevio (Eusebio). The informant in Luis' death certificate (1941) is his niece's husband, Rafael Regalado. Maybe Col. Teleforo and Franciscà had Matias in San Antonio, Tx. before they returned to Matamoros, Mexico (??). In Jacinto's death certificate it shows both his parents, Matias & Felipa, as being born in Mexico, however his mother's maiden name is spelled "Musqueda" instead of "Mosqueda".

My father, Reynaldo Ruiz Alvarez, always said his grandfather's family on the Alvarez side came from the Matamoros, Mexico area. I'm sure church records in Matamoros, Mexico would reveal the correct information regarding their births, marriages, deaths, burial, etc. King Ranch archivist, Bruce Cheeseman, might know where Matias and Felipa are buried.....maybe even the "Angel of Goliad".

Luis and Augustina lived in the "Santa Cruz" section of the Santa Getrudis Division of the King Ranch. (located between Kingsville & Riviera.....west of Hwy 77). We think that most of their children were born there. Accounts also place some of Luis' brothers and sisters also living in or near the "Santa Cruz" area (ex. Rita Alvarez Qunitanilla). Tomasa Alvarez Quintanilla, one of Rita's daughter's, met her husband, Lauro Cavazos, Sr. there in "Santa Cruz".

Luis and Augustina had 20 children. However 10 died before becoming adults. We don't know their names as of today or where they are buried. The remaining children that grew up to become adults are listed above, except we don't know about Gregoria, they say she died young when she was trampled by a horse or run over by a wagon.
